A handicapped accessible bathroom is available on the main floor of the church.

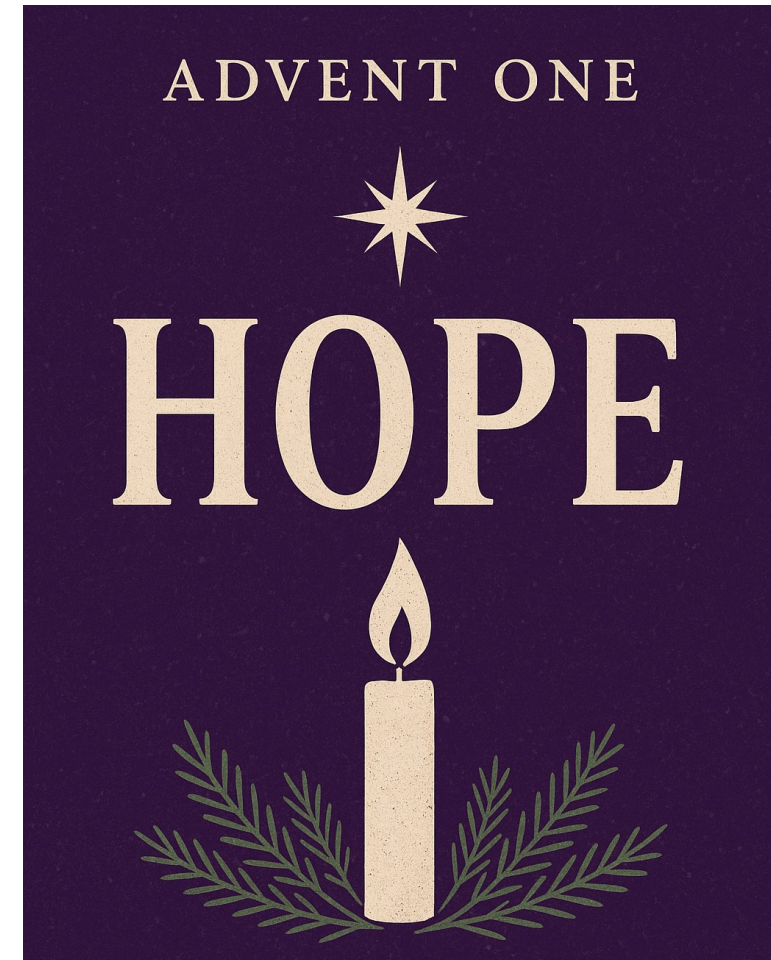
Parking. Please save spaces near the front of the church for those who have difficulty walking. One handicapped space is available on Caernarvan St. near the ramp.
