

STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

Pastor Jane's message a few weeks ago prompted me to rethink my own version of discipleship. After studying I could summarize my thoughts as *discipleship isn't supposed to be convenient*. Believers have come to expect our spiritual lives should fit into our schedules. We want Transformation, but we want it in a 60 minute window on Sundays!

Discipleship isn't meant to be efficient or easy. Jesus meant it to be costly. Luke 9:23 And he said to them all, "If you want to come with me, you must forget yourself, take up your cross every day, and follow me."

I remember this scripture from when I was a new believer. I feared what life would be like as a believer. Would my family and friends still be there? How was I supposed to figure out what was expected of me? Fast forward to who I am now and the church family I am part of. If pursuit of a life with Jesus hasn't challenged our egos, life habits or our daily schedule, it might be time to ask yourself if you are following Jesus or simply admiring Him. Being a disciple can be done in simple steps, but it is not a spectator sport. So, we will set up a tent in the rain to offer our neighbors something like a warm beverage or sharing our bathroom.
